MYHealth Summer Launch Research Training Program

What Happens in MYHealth?

High school students will join a fun and engaging community of peers, researchers, and faculty at the University of Michigan to learn about research by working alongside our research team on a real-life research project. In each session, students will play games, share experiences and opinions, and learn about research on an applied project.

MYHealth would be a great opportunity for students who are:

- Looking for a short-term or flexible summer opportunity
- Seeking opportunities to enhance their college applications
- Hoping to build skills in STEM, research, and teamwork
- Working to build connections with researchers, scientists, and faculty at the University level

MYHealth students complete an interactive research training curriculum led by UM faculty from the schools of Social Work, Education, and Medicine. Students will learn about what research is and have the opportunity to design and complete a research project on a topic of their choosing using MyVoice ([hearmyvoicenow.org](https://hear.myvoice.now.org)), a national poll of youth, to survey 1,000+ 14-25 year olds each week on topics that matter to them. Historically, MyVoice survey questions have focused on adolescent health topics including mental health, vaccination, healthcare access, and more. **MYHealth students will work in teams to develop their own survey questions, review and analyze responses, and share findings with their community.**

Who Can Participate:

- Current high school students (9th-11th grade) in Southeast Michigan
- Must be able to attend the 10-day **virtual** Summer Launch program
- Must self-identify as someone who is underrepresented in science or research careers.

Time Commitment:

10 weekdays, July 18 – July 29, 2022

MYHealth is a free and virtual opportunity! Students are paid for the time they spend in the program and for completing surveys and interviews. Students will be loaned a computer for the duration of the program.
